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How to write a motivation letter?

1. Write an outline

- Write points covering the following topics:Why you want to study the course
- Your skills or qualities that will benefit the program
- Why you are interested in the program



Write an introduction

Introduce yourself.

3. Write the body of the letter

Expand the points. Remember, your motivation letter aims to convince your recipient of your value, so use compelling facts to be persuasive.

4. Conclude your motivation letter

Write a conclusion that summarizes your goal and leaves a positive final impression. You should also thank your recipient for considering your application and encourage them to contact you if they have any questions.
