WELCOME TO SIBIU

Let Sibiu surprise you.

Any tourist guide of Sibiu will help you find out a lot of interesting things about the well-known landmarks and tourist attractions. Additionally, we have listed a few suggestions to give your experience a little extra charm.

Discover traditions, culture and folk art in the open-air **Astra Museum**: with over 400 architectural and folk-art monuments, exhibited on nearly 100 hectares, Astra Museum is Europe's largest open-air ethnographic exhibition. It will surprise you to find out that the largest windmill collection in the world is here and not in Holland.

Take a look at Sibiu from above: there are two towers from which you have a splendid view over the entire city up to the **Făgăraș Mountain** crests: the **Evangelical Church Tower** and the **Council Tower**. Additionally, you can enjoy a drink or meal while watching the sunset in the panoramic restaurant of the 4-star hotel Golden Tulip Ana Tower (585 Fusion restaurant, located at the 11th floor on 2 Școala de Înot street).



WELCOME TO SIBIU

Explore the network of hidden passages and stairs which connect the city's **Upper Town** and **Lower Town**: They are a distinct brand of Sibiu and add a mysterious touch to the city centre. The narrow streets open from place to place to small squares, where the sounds of the city fade away. Head towards **Pasajul Scărilor** or **Turnul Scării Aurarilor**. Near Casa cu Cariatide you can find another "hidden passage" which will take you to **Nicolae Bălcescu street** (the main walking and shopping street in the historical center). And these are just a few of them.

Tired already?!

Enjoy a craft beer, a glass of wine, coffee, or a snack. There are a lot of options especially in the Large and Small Square. To narrow them down, you might want to stop at NOD Pub (in the Small Square), The Refresh (in the Large Square, for a healthy energy boost; you can order only at the bar), Cafe Wien (Huet Square, for an authentic feel of a typical coffeehouse in Vienna). Looking for a place closer to the conference venue?! How about Thurta Grill and Bar or Grădina, to name a few of the many options.

HOW TO GET TO & FROM THE AIRPORT

The airport is 15/20 min away from the city center of Sibiu.

The main ways to get into the city are by:

- **Bolt** or **Uber**:
- **Taxi** (example of companies: yellow vehicles with 942, 953 written on them). Use only cabs which display transportation license, prices and are using taximeters. The maximum tariff for taxi services approved by City Hall of Sibiu is 3,93 lei / km (most of them accept just cash payments);
- **Bus**: bus line 11 (to downtown) stops 300 meters away from the airport. Bus tickets (3 lei, valid 60 minutes after scanning the QR code / card) can be paid by card (on the yellow contactless devices within the bus) or through the SibiuBus app. Details about the route are available at **www.tursib.ro/trasee/harta** or within SibiuBus app (bus line 11 is shown in purple).

FOR ENROLMENT AT ULBS FOR **STUDIES**, YOU NEED TO:

1. Be nominated by your home institution through the Google form provided on our website: <https://international.ulbsibiu.ro/erasmus/erasmus-incoming-students/>
2. After the nomination you will be required to send the Application Form for mobilities for studies coming from EU countries and Learning agreement filled in using OLA platform <https://www.learning-agreement.eu/> and Erasmus+ App (available in Google Play and Apple store) at the following e-mail address: **international@ulbsibiu.ro**;

Required documents:

- Passport or ID card
- CV
- English language certificate (minimum level B1);
- Learning Agreement for Studies (section Before Mobility) signed by both coordinators;
- Transcript of Records from your home university;
- Medical assurance/ European Student Card.

After the nomination period is closed and you send us all the documents mentioned you will be issued an acceptance letter



ERASMUS INCOMING STUDENTS (EUROPE, TURKEY) APPLICATION PROCEDURES

FOR ENROLMENT AT ULBS FOR **TRAINEESHIP** YOU NEED TO:

1. Be nominated by your home institution through the Google form provided on our website: <https://international.ulbsibiu.ro/erasmus/erasmus-incoming-students/>
2. After the nomination you will be required to send the **Application form for mobility for Traineeships** for students coming from EU countries and **Learning Agreement Traineeships** at the following e-mail address: international@ulbsibiu.ro;

Required documents:

- Passport or ID card
- CV
- English language certificate (minimum level B1);
- Learning Agreement for Studies (section Before Mobility) signed by both coordinators;
- Transcript of Records from your home university;
- Medical assurance/ European Student Card

After the nomination period is closed and you send us all the documents mentioned you will be issued an acceptance letter.



ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURE FOR NON-EU CITIZENS

ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY

- You have documents that attest your citizenship from EU third countries
- You are a graduate of high-school and you have baccalaureate diploma or an equivalent diploma that allows general access to accredited higher education institutions for bachelor's degree studies:
